What grades do I need to apply for an Apprenticeship?

For a Level 2 Apprenticeship you will ideally need a minimum of grade 3 GCSE in Maths, English & Science.
For a Level 3 Apprenticeship, ideally a minimum of grade 4 GCSE in Maths, English, Science and any other subjects.

What is involved in an Engineering Apprenticeship?

Many Apprentices will spend the first 6-9 months in the training centre completing theoretical and practical component parts of the Apprenticeship, others will attend on an alternative block release basis. After this, they would then return to the employing company to complete years 2, 3 and 4.

Each Apprentice is allocated a dedicated Training Assessor (TA) who will support them throughout the term of their Apprenticeship. Some Apprentices can take their Apprenticeship to the next level and complete a Higher National Certificate (HNC, Level 4) here at Elevated Knowledge after completion of a Level 3 Apprenticeship, subject to employer approval.

How will I get an Employer?

As an Apprentice you will be employed by one of our employing companies, which means you are paid whilst you are learning. Elevated Knowledge work with companies from across Greater Manchester and the High Peak to recruit and train Apprentices. Our Apprentices are selected by our companies from our pool of applicants who would then undertake a company interview and possibly work placement. You can always look for your own employer by applying to companies you would like to work for.

Please note: An employer interview through Elevated Knowledge is not 100% guaranteed. Our Recruitment Team are here to help you plan your career into engineering.
